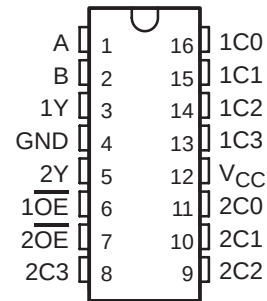

description

Each of these data selectors/multiplexers contains inverters and drivers to supply full binary decoding data selection to the AND-OR gates. Separate strobe output-enable ($1OE$ or $2OE$) inputs are provided for each of the two four-line sections.

The 3-state outputs can interface with and drive data lines of bus-organized systems. With all but one of the common outputs disabled (at a high-impedance state), the low impedance of the single enabled output will drive the bus line to a high or low logic level. Each output has its own strobe. The output is disabled when its strobe is high.

The 74AC11353 is characterized for operation from -40°C to 85°C .

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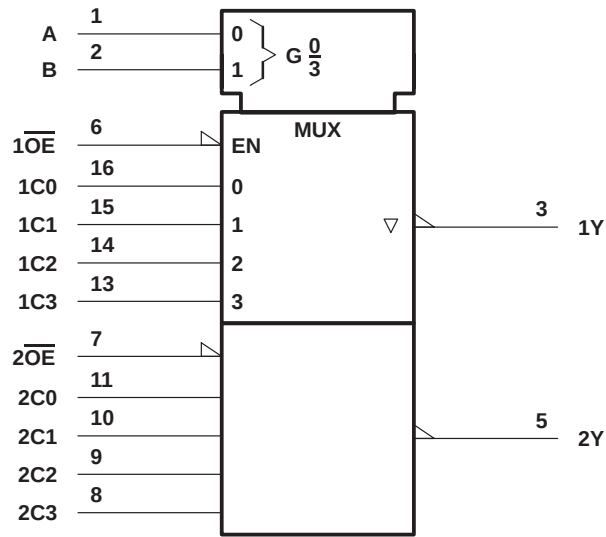

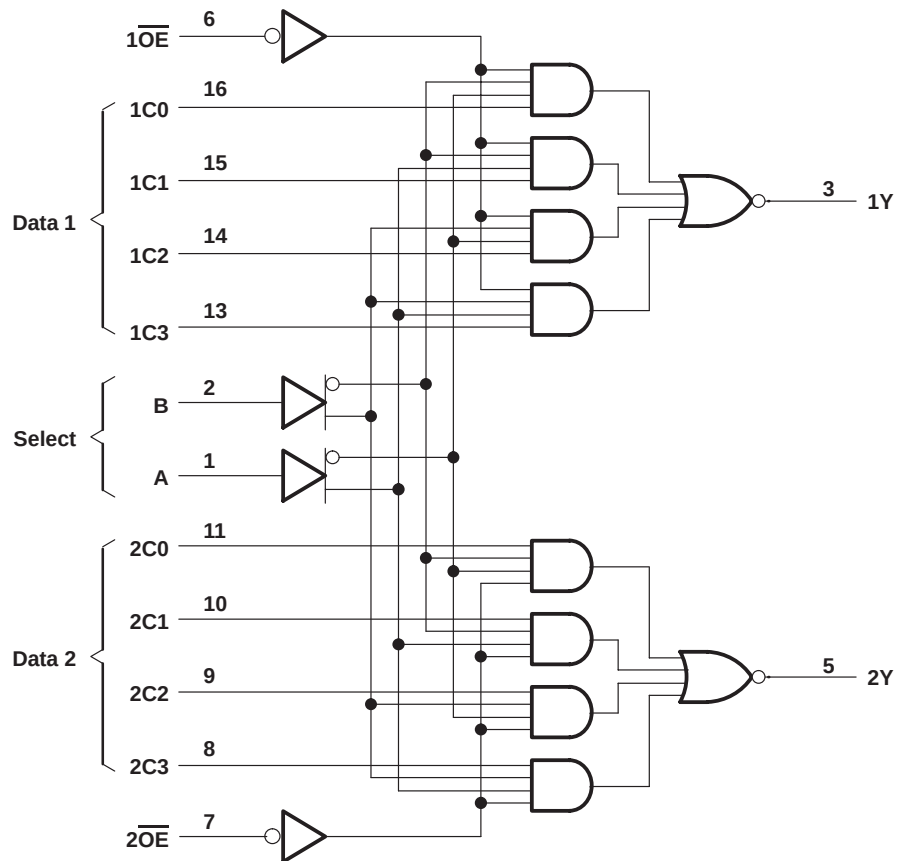
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logic symbol†

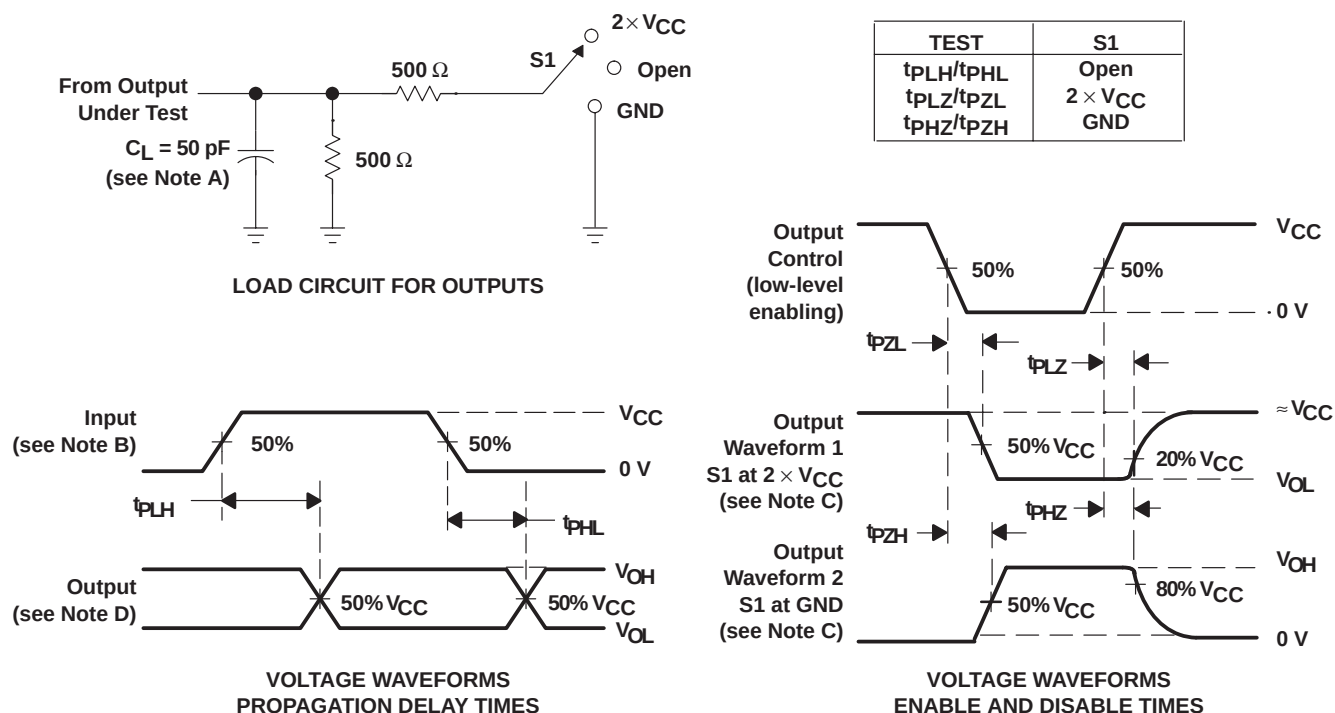

- NOTES: A. C_L includes probe and jig capacitance.
 B. All input pulses are supplied by generators having the following characteristics: $PRR \leq 10\text{ MHz}$, $Z_0 = 50\ \Omega$, $t_r \leq 3\text{ ns}$, $t_f \leq 3\text{ ns}$. For testing pulse duration: $t_r = t_f = 1\text{ to }3\text{ ns}$. Pulse polarity can be either high-to-low-to-high or low-to-high-to-low.
 C. Waveform 1 is for an output with internal conditions such that the output is low except when disabled by the output control. Waveform 2 is for an output with internal conditions such that the output is high except when disabled by the output control.
 D. The outputs are measured one at a time with one transition per measurement.
